The following list of musicianship questions should be answered during the exam. Further guidelines on specific requirements for each grade can be found in the LCME ukulele syllabus.

Grade 1:

Musicianship Questions

All questions should be answered after the performance section:

- Choose one of your melodies or rhythm studies and name:
 - the time signature
 - the key signature
- Play and name the following notes from the C major scale:
 - Fret 2 on the C String
 - Fret 3 on the E String
- Point to and name the following parts of the Ukulele:
 - ∘ Tuners
 - ∘ Bridge
 - Fretboard
 - · Each open string

Grade 2:

Musicianship Questions

All questions should be answered after the performance section:

- Choose one of your melodies or rhythm studies and name:
 - ${\scriptstyle \circ}$ the time signature
 - the key signature
- Play and name the following notes:
 - Fret 1 on the E String
 - Fret 1 on the A String
 - Fret 2 on the C String
- Point to and name the following parts of the Ukulele:
 - Tuners
 - \circ Nut
 - ∘ Saddle

Grade 3

Musicianship Questions

All questions should be answered after the performance section:

- Choose two of your melodies and/or rhythm studies and name:
 - the time signature
 - the key signature
- Play and name the following notes:
 - Fret 3 on the G String
 - Fret 2 on the E String
 - Fret 4 on the A String
- Point to and name the following parts of the Ukulele:
 - Frets
 - Marker Dots
 - Soundboard
 - Soundhole

Grade 4

Musicianship Questions

All questions should be answered after the performance section:

- Choose one of your pieces or rhythm studies and name:
 - the time signature
 - the key signature
 - its tempo, mood and style
- Explain why you chose to perform this piece
- Demonstrate one technique used in the piece
- Play and name the following notes:
 - Fret 8 on the A String
 - Fret 6 on the E String
 - Fret 7 on the C String

Grade 5

Musicianship Questions

All questions should be answered after the performance section:

- Which is your favourite piece and why did you choose it?
 - name the time signature
 - name the key signature
 - $^{\circ}$ explain the meaning of two of the dynamics used in the score
 - briefly outline how the tempo, mood and style compare with another piece or rhythm study you performed
- Demonstrate two techniques used in the pieces you performed
- Play and name the following notes:
 - Fret 11 on the A String
 - Fret 12 on the E String
 - Fret 8 on the C String

Grade 6

Musicianship Questions

All questions should be answered after the performance section:

- Play and name two of the following notes:
 - Fret 9 on the C String
 - Fret 11 on the G String
 - Fret 10 on the A String
- · Name two well-known ukulele players and their most famous piece/song/arrangement.
- Name the following parts of the Ukulele:
 - ∘ Saddle
 - Bridge
 - Fret markers
- Name two different types or sizes of ukulele.

Grade 7

Musicianship Questions

All questions should be answered after the performance section:

- Play and name two of following notes:
 - Fret 13 on the C String
 - Fret 14 on the A String
 - Fret 15 on the E String
- Explain why you chose to perform one of the pieces and demonstrate one technique used in the piece
- Name one well-known ukulele player and their most famous piece/song/arrangement.
- Point to and name the following parts of the Ukulele:
 - ∘ Tuners
 - ∘ Saddle
 - Soundboard
 - Soundhole

Grade 8

Musicianship Questions

All questions should be answered after the performance section:

- Play and name two of following notes:
 - Fret 14 on the A String
 - Fret 11 on the C String
 - Fret 13 on the E String
 - Fret 15 on the G String
- Name a technique you used today in your pieces and explain how it is used in ukulele playing and demonstrate using the ukulele how this is done.
- Give a brief outline of the ukulele history and its origins. Naming some notable players and how they have influenced and popularised the instrument.
